William Shatner was born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada on March 22, 1931. Best known for having played Captain James T. Kirk on *Star Trek* (1966-69), one mustn't forget his roles as T. J. Hooker in the cop show of that very name (1982-86) or attorney Denny Crane on *Boston Legal* (2004-2008). Nowadays he plays Dr. Edison Milford Goodson III on *\$#! My Dad Says* and is the host of *Shatner's Raw Nerve* on The Biography Channel.

This year Shatner is turning eighty years old. In recognition of more than a half century's contributions to the silver screen, Shatner Day honors the man, the legend, and the essence that is William Shatner.

The insignia for Shatner Day 2011 emphasizes his *Star Trek* past. Like some phantom apparition, the spectral form of the starship *Enterprise* emerges from mists that enshroud it, the vessel's running lights shining through the grey haze. The six command stars along either side and the seventh, larger star in the center represent the *Star Trek* films that Shatner starred in.

“Spectre” is the title of Shatner’s fourth *Star Trek* novel, the plot of which features Kirk being forced to assist alternate versions of Spock and Kathryn Janeway in confronting threats beleaguering the Terran Empire in the Mirror Universe. Honestly.
