William Shatner was born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada on March 22, 1931. Best known for having played Captain James T. Kirk on *Star Trek* (1966-69), one mustn't forget his roles as T. J. Hooker in the cop show of that very name (1982-86) or attorney Denny Crane on *Boston Legal* (2004-08). He was also the host of *Shatner's Raw Nerve* on The Biography Channel (2008-11).

This year Shatner is turning eighty-one years old. In recognition of more than a half century's contributions to the silver screen, Shatner Day honors the man, the legend, and the essence that is William Shatner.

Kirk's desperate gamble in *Star Trek III: The Search for Spock* (1983). This dark moment of ultimate sacrifice paved the way to a pyrrhic victory at day's end. Though he lost the battle, Kirk was determined to win the war.

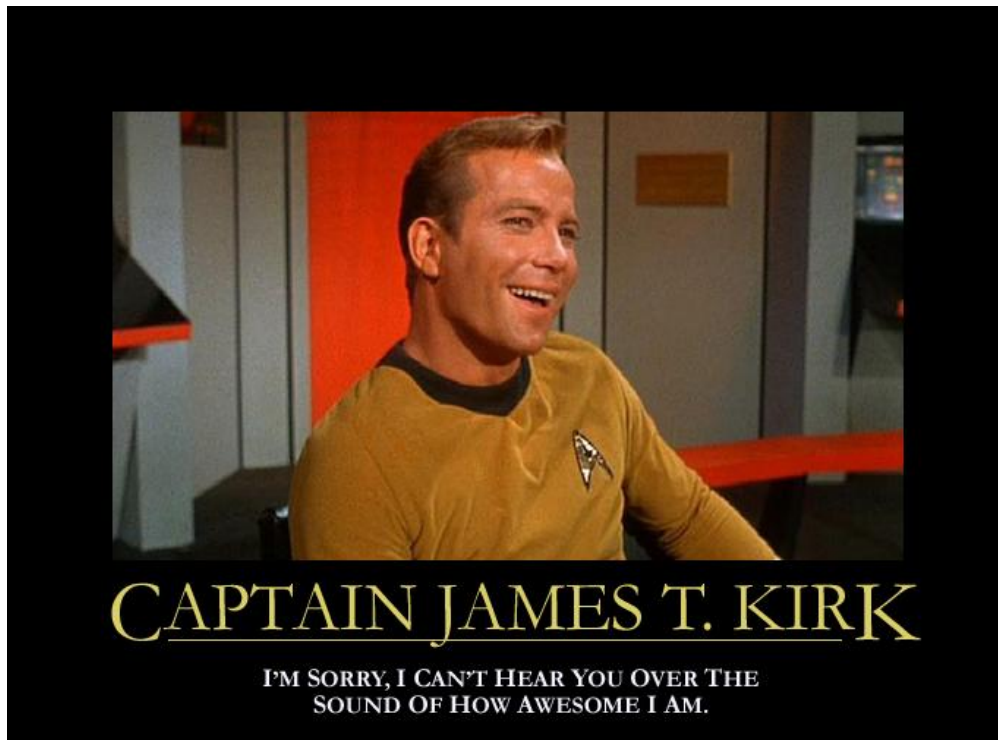
